

New Features in Pocket Bird Recorder 4

General	
Supported OS	Windows Mobile 2003, Windows Mobile 2003 SE, Windows Mobile 5
User Interface	Portrait and Landscape supported on 2003 SE and Mobile 5
GPS	On Windows Mobile 5 Pocket Bird can use the GPS at the same time as other Mobile 5 compliant apps (e.g. SatNav). In Mobile 2003 only 1 app at a time could use the GPS receiver.
Help	Full help provided on the device.
Searching for Species	It is now possible to search using Quick Codes downloaded from the Wildlife Recorder or Wildlife Lister species database. You can of course still search for species using the common or scientific names.
Interface With Wildlife Lister and Recorder	
Uploading data	It is no longer necessary for Pocket Bird Recorder to be closed on the device.
Workspaces	You can easily hold data for more than 1 Recorder or Lister workspace on your device
Backup/Restore	The backup, restore and switch database facilities are integrated into Pocket Bird Recorder. In previous versions they were supplied as separate programs.
Trips	
Times	If you are not interested in recording the time you can switch off times.
End Time	After you have completed selecting all the species for a trip and asked for them to be saved you can automatically save the end time of the trip.
Site Selection	The last 5 sites selected are saved. You can select from the recently used site list or search for a site in the site list.
GPS and Altitude	You can now enter the exact location coordinates and altitude for the trip. These can be entered manually or obtained from an attached GPS receiver. Previously Location coordinates could only be recorded for a site.

Sites	
County	In previous versions you could enter Site, State and Country details for each site. In addition County information can also be entered.
County, State and Country Selection	In previous versions State and Country names had to be keyed in. In the latest version they can also be selected from drop-downs showing the names of those already known on the device.
Delete	In previous versions it was not possible to delete a site record from the device. Deletion is now supported although a site cannot be deleted if it has been used in any sightings,
Species	
Distribution Notes	If the device species list was uploaded from the latest version of the Wildlife Recorder Birds database, distribution notes about the species can be displayed.
Delete	In previous versions it was not possible to delete a species record from the device. Deletion is now supported although a species cannot be deleted if it has been used in any sightings,
Counts	Previous versions had no knowledge of species and sub-species so all counts referred to sub-species. The new version understands the difference between species and sub-species therefore counts refer to full species.
